

## Trinity Response to a POSITIVE COVID-19 Test Results for Students and Staff



Positive test result must be reported to school officials.

If exposure happened on campus, contact will be traced, families will be contacted, and appropriate restrictions, closures, and quarantines will be put in place in accordance with guidance from the Amarillo Department of Public Health.

If there was no contact on campus, the infected individual will be quarantined according to directions from the Amarillo Department of Public Health.
